EARLY START BRAVES THE STORM!



All 12 kiddos and their parents participated on Thursday, despite the forecast! Another Early Start session followed the following week with 8 families in attendance.

As a result, many of these special children with diagnosis ranging from cerebral palsy to Down syndrome and autism made some significant developmental gains.
